April & interim Schwab investment statements: During April the investment had a minor unrealized loss in total value in the short term, recovered by the end of the month & now, by mid-May is ahead of the prior month (March) results. As opined at the last meeting, the expected choppy market & dip was short lived. Market analysis now indicates a strong market growth for the rest of the calendar year with the continuing "on shoring" of business and production, the capital infusion by overseas entities in the current \$10 Trillion dollar estimate, "Made in America" initiatives, tariff/tax policies along with a pro-
